

ROSA ELENA CHILDCARE CENTER INTERGENERATIONAL SCHEDULE

Magic is created when young children and adult individuals with Alzheimer's disease interact in a safe and caring environment. The Alzheimer's Activity Center (AAC) has more than 20 years of providing opportunities for both generations to benefit from the special relationships that develop.

The Rosa Elena Child Care Center (RECC) and the AAC has created a unique intergenerational program, where preschoolers interact with individuals with Alzheimer's disease. We offer a variety of activities including, arts and crafts, story time, large group activities, song, dance and social interaction.

WEEKLY ACTIVITIES

MONDAY	OPEN ACTIVITY
TUESDAY	STORY TIME, each Tuesday one of the AAC clients will visit the RECC and read to the children at 10:30 am. The AAC provides the guest to read and the RECC provides the book.
WEDNESDAY	STORY TIME, each Wednesday one of our preschool groups joins a group of seniors in the AAC for story time at 10:30 am for this fun filled activity.
THURSDAY	ACTIVITY TIME, each Thursday the children join the adults in the AAC for a special arts & craft projects at 10:30 am. The RECC and AAC staff work together to develop age appropriate activities. Our preschool groups will rotate weekly for this activity.
FRIDAY	OUTSIDE PLAY, each Friday a group of preschoolers go into the "big backyard" and play a large group game at 3:15 pm. These games include; soccer, water play, parachute, bubbles, and horseshoes.

LARGE MONTHLY ACTIVITIES

The RECC and the AAC often do large activities once or twice per month - depending on the season. Generally these activities are holiday based. For example: Halloween, holiday season party or Valentine's Day party. Families are welcome to join us for these! The date, time and scope of activity will be posted in advance. **All activities will be supervised by trained AAC & RECC staff.**
